Constantia (Map on the next page for directions)

- 1) **Theo's** (021 794 4930) = excellent quality steak and fish restaurant. Booking essential in high season. Children welcome. Located in the Constantia Village Shopping Centre.
Wasabi (021 794 6546) = excellent quality Japanese restaurant. Children welcome. Located in the Constantia Village Shopping Centre.
- 2) **Primi Piatti** (021 794 7771) = pizza and pasta restaurant. Children welcome. Located in the Constantia Village Shopping Centre.
- 3) **Buitenverwachting** (021 794 3522) = stunning wine and food. Often voted in the Top 10 restaurants in South Africa.
- 4) **Groot Constantia** (021 794 1143) = excellent cuisine and wine. Simon's Restaurant newly opened (021 794 6255). Contemporary décor. Beautiful location. Jonkershuis Restaurant (021 794 6255).
- 5) **Klein Constantia** (021 794 5188) = Beautiful location, food and wine.
- 6) **Constantia Uitsig** (021 794 1810) = La Colombe Restaurant has been voted top restaurant in South Africa for three years, and serves traditional French-Provencal cuisine of the very highest standard. The River Café serves lighter meals in a stunning vineyard setting (021 794 3010).
- 7) **Steenberg Vineyards** (021 713 2222) = Catharina's restaurant is located in the original winery built in 1682 and is now tastefully decorated in Cape colonial style.
- 8) **Hohenort Cellars – The Greenhouse Restaurant** (021 794 2137) = Electric menu offers a range of flavours, tastes and experiences with an emphasis on the indigenous, the organic and the fresh.
- 9) **Alphen Hotel** (021 794 5011) = Informal and formal. Cloete's in the Manor House. A fine dining a la carte restaurant.
- 10) **Barbarella's** (021 794 2411) = Bright and breezy café style place between a shopping centre and a car park. Local favourite for a casual bite. Located in the Constantia Village Shopping Centre.
- 11) **Peddlers on the Bend** (021 794 7747) = A popular country pub and bistro with fireplace is literally on the bend of a busy road (Spaanschemat River Road). Large outside gravel garden with patio furniture under umbrellas. Booking recommended.

Claremont

- 1) **Au Jardin** (021 657 4500) = Fine diner with its beautiful garden has always been charming, with contemporary design to offset the big windows with mountain views. Also an informal 'bistro' section. **Location:** The Vineyard Hotel.
- 2) **Brad's Grill** (021 671 2527) = A real local gem steakhouse. Great quality steaks and BIG PORTIONS. **Location:** 69 2nd Avenue.

Gardens

- 1) **Aubergine** (021 465 4909) = Intense and pure flavours, superb sauces. Good, discreet service and a great wine list to round off the experience. Rated as one of the Top 10 restaurants in South Africa. **Location:** 39 Barnet Street.

V & A Waterfront

- 1) **Baia** (021 421 0935) = Upmarket seafood place with superb views of the harbor and large patio spaces for summer days. Very proficient service.
- 2) **Green Dolphin** (021 421 7471) = Grills, pastas and salads - all named after jazz players. Great live jazz. Bar area upstairs and down, deck seating for sunny days.
- 3) **Quay 4** (021 419 2008) = Incredible views. Right on the harbor. Simple but delicious meals. Great pastas, pizzas, salads, ciabatta and specialities on the blackboard.

City

- 1) **Ginja** (021 426 2368) = One of the city's most sexiest venues, the food is lively and the service is sure of itself. Reservations essential. Great Asian flavours. **Location:** 121 Castle Street.
- 2) **Jardine Restaurant** (021 424 5640) = With a European café vibe, downstairs lounge/bar and upstairs open-kitchen dining. Very good meats, the artful plates are flavor-rich, if often savoury and heavy, but diners are very happy. **Location:** 185 Bree Street.
- 3) **Mama Afrika** (021 424 8634) = Trendy African cuisine. Music starts at 20:00 with dancers, drummers and music. Mainly meaty grills, game dishes. **Location:** 178 Long Street.
- 4) **The Showroom** (021 421 4682) = Sits on a busy intersection, alongside a luxury car showroom. Very chic and cosmopolitan. The kitchen is on show from both levels for your entertainment. Bold flavours and many sauces. There is also a separate deck menu. **Location:** 101 Hospital Street

Kalk Bay

- 1) **Harbour House** (021 788 4133) = Incredible views of the harbor and sea. Great fish, seafood, steaks and lamb. **Location:** Kalk Bay Harbour

Franschoek

- 1) **Haute Cabriere** (021 876 3688) = A unique place built into the mountainside and set above a wine cellar. Great steaks and lamb chops. Beautifully presented food and great service. **Location:** Pass Road
- 2) **La Petite Ferme** (021 876 3016) = Beautiful views of the valley. Afro-Asian inspired dishes with bold combinations. Trout is a speciality. **Location:** Pass Road
- 3) **Mange Tout** (021 876 2770) = Incredible mountain views. French inspired luxury foods. **Location:** Mont Rochelle Hotel, Dassenberg
- 4) **Reuben's** (021 876 3772) = Wonderful food with Asian touches. Warm feel and a lovely courtyard. **Location:** Huguenot Street
- 5) **The Tasting Room** (021 876 2151) = Great wine and food. Fine dining and precise flavours on pretty plates with a live pianist. **Location:** Le Quartier Francais, Huguenot Road
