

# **Shopping Malls**

## **1) Constantia Mall**

Upmarket shopping centre very close to Karibou Guest Lodge. There is a variety of designer stores, Woolworths, Pick n Pay. ALL main banks are represented.

## **2) Cavendish Square**

Main shopping mall for the area. Significantly bigger than Constantia mall. Large variety of designer stores and department stores. Approximately 15 minutes driving time from Karibou Guest Lodge. Also has a multiplex cinema, and an “art” cinema. Food court with a number of fast food outlets. Located behind the main road in Claremont.

## **3) V & A Waterfront**

Luxury shopping mall located right on the waterfront. Many beautiful restaurants with sea and mountain views. Large variety of designer stores and department stores. Remember this is a tourist destination and so whilst the restaurants still offer good value for money, they are significantly more expensive than other locations in Cape Town.

## **4) Canal Walk/ Century City**

Truly enormous shopping mall. Features a multiplex cinema, “art” cinema, go-cart racing track, MTN Science Centre plus loads of clothing stores. There is also a Pick n Pay, Woolworths and all the major department stores have shops here.

### **5) N1 City Mall**

Small centre with a big Hypermarket, Game and Pick n Pay. Good for electrical appliances and groceries. Lots of parking. 15KM from the centre of Cape Town, N1 turnoff "Montevista/Edgemead," turn right.

### **6) Tyger Valley Centre**

Big centre with predominantly Afrikaans customers. Cinema's, restaurants, bistros, bookshops, banks. Very good for clothing, jewellery, sports articles, household ware, appliances, toys, photo and computer. Nice boutiques. Entertainment area. Big parking ground. Take the N1 towards Durbanville Rd, take exit 25, then left.

### **7) St Georges Mall**

City Centre. Historical buildings, banks and press. Large clothing stores (Edgars, Woolworths, Truworths etc. Stalls with ethnic clothes, arts and crafts and cafes. Little parking.

### **8) Gardens Mall**

Small centre with Pick n Pay groceries, good European fashion stop for men, German meat and sausages with snack bar. Clothing stores. Restaurants and bistros. Parkhouse. Corner of Mill and Buitenkant Streets.
